- Please indicate your preference for Oral or Poster; depending on the number of submissions for oral presentations it may not be possible to provide slots for every talk. In this case the Steering Committee (SC) may need to ask you to present a poster instead.

 For (full) article submission for Proceedings, the BPG site will be used after the meeting in October. Prepare for sharp deadline of December 31st, 2019!
